National flags will be paraded across the Yaquina Bay Bridge as they arrive for their official posting. The 2009 Field of Honor will be established southeast of the bridge on Port of Newport property. Imagine a field of 1000 flags all posted in a grid-like pattern, accessible to anyone wishing to honor a Veteran or remember our national history. Some flags are named for fallen Veterans and those missing in action. Others carry the names of someone dearly remembered by family members and friends.
